

# Satfi UK+ Manual

The general operation of the Satfi UK+ is simple. The unit comprises of a control panel and control box. The control panel should be easily visible, the control box may be hidden inside a cupboard or behind the scenes.

## Control Panel



The control panel has an on/off button and an UP and a Down button. Pressing the main on/off button will wake the antenna. It will then go to the last satellite that it tracked. After waking the antenna, you can alter the satellite you would like to track by using the UP or Down button until your desired satellite is lit by the blue LED light. Pressing the on/off again button will shut it down.

## Control Box

There is an on/off switch and a USB port. The USB allows the unit to be updated. Sky boxes users should be aware that Sky update their boxes around 3am. This may cause the antenna to wake and rotate. Avtex TVs may also cause the antenna to rotate with their wake on demand feature Sky box and Avtex users may choose to use the on/off switch on the Control Box to avoid this happening.



Software updates, firmware or satellite frequencies can be emailed to you. They should be downloaded to a blank USB stick and inserted into the USB port. The unit should then be switched on and the update will happen automatically.

All satellite antennas need a clear unobstructed view of the sky. Blockage such as trees or buildings will prevent the system from locking on.
